### **WRITER'S NOTES**



While this play is fictional, it is undeniably rooted in and inspired by events from my life. Names have been altered, experiences merged, and creative liberties have absolutely been taken. Yet, at its core, it is based on a true story.

Writing a piece so close to my heart has been a challenge – a labour of love and, most importantly, a celebration of the indomitable spirit of my extraordinary sister, Estee, aka Tae Tae. As COVID-19 began its global spread, Tae found herself confined to a hospital bed, navigating complications from another spinal surgery. With our family overseas, I chose to stay by her side, rediscovering the bond we once shared as children, but now experiencing it as two grown women. Through early morning chats and late-night Uber Eats orders, we weathered the challenges of the hospital, enveloped by its constant sounds and rhythms.

Tae's resilience during that time deeply resonated with me, reminding me of the incredible story she holds within. It became clear that her journey deserved to be shared, not just with our family, but with the world. Thus, the idea for *Tae Tae in the Land of Yaaas!* was born – a play designed to encapsulate her spirit, entertain with a twist on classic fairytales, and convey a poignant message.

A bunch of people aided in shaping this script, playing significant roles in moulding its characters and narrative. Maya and Maxi, thank you for being game. We might have thrown you into deep waters, but you've swum gracefully alongside us. Johnny and Helen, you effortlessly infuse love and joy into the story – collaboratively sculpting these characters has been a joy. My two partners in crime, Ross and Nick – thank you for believing in this story. I've needed your support and strength more than ever throughout this process, and I am forever grateful for your friendship and encouragement.

A heartfelt thanks to my wonderful family. Special shout out to my two older sisters Estee and Emma who helped craft this story with me. And, of course, a huge thank you to my mum, Lesley, and stepdad, Pete – thank you for, well, everything.

Thank you for being a part of this experience, and I can't wait to see you in the Land of YAAAS!


















































### **Q&A WITH THE REAL TAE TAE (ESTEE LEE)**

### The question you are asked most?

Can I help you with that? And sometimes... Let me help you with that!

### To you, "Disability" means ...?

To me the word disability means impacting on life. This impact goes beyond the person living with the 'disability' – everyone in this person's life feels the impacts of this disability. Whether or not this impact holds you back from living an amazing life totally depends on your mindset, your resilience and human connection with others.

### What would you tell your 16-year-old self?

Even though life seems pretty shitty right now and you wish you were like all the other girls, you are going to have the most fabulous, exciting, successful life. You don't need to be like anyone else, you just need to be yourself! Different is normal – so let your differences shine, own this shit and make the world yours girl!

Oh and PS: That guy who you love but he won't give you the time of day or even talk to you because he is too busy hitting on the girls that are 'perfect' – he turns out to be not all that!

### What's it like seeing your story on stage?

I knew this would be an emotional process, but when I actually heard the cast read the script for the first time, it was surreal – so deeply emotional.

Seeing this story on stage does take me back to the shitty, horrible times in my life, but instead of remembering them as shitty and horrible, I remember them as obstacles that I had to get through to get to my life now – which is pretty bloody fantastic. Humour and connection is how my life rolls and my sister has so perfectly captured this.

I don't think that anyone could have coupled humour with such a dramatic true story other than Nelle. I am so humbled that shake & stir see my life, well parts of my life, as worthy of putting on stage. I am really proud to be able to support s&s with showcasing this story which I think is going to mean so much to so many people for so many different reasons. I have always been shake & stir's Number 1 fan so it goes without saying that I am so, so proud of my little sis and the creatives, cast and crew of this incredible company.

I have never thought that I was doing anything special or 'inspiring' (hate that word) because I have been living my life just like everyone else, but this has been a special experience. This show presents very challenging themes that we all may go through – and how we overcome them is such a strong thread in the story. I love that it's based on fact but dusted in magic. If only I had had a Maxi Shield Fairy Godmother growing up – she is FAB and symbolises so much more than a Tinker Bell.

### Any advice for those struggling with motivation at the moment?

You got this! Own your choices – they are yours and no one else's. Accept your reality – life is what it is, if we could magically go back in time of course we would, but sadly we don't have a Fairy Godmother, so this is it – you are here and your mind can overcome anything! Love and value the people who have and do come into your life – and I promise, life will soar for you!

#### Your life in three words?

Tenacious, Grateful, Vulnerable.


#### **MAXI SHIELD**


